

Quick Start Guide to: Getting started with a basic D2L course

The most basic D2L course site provides content and grades for your students. The 5 steps below will guide you through obtaining a D2L course site, enrolling members of your teaching team, adding content and configuring the gradebook for your new D2L course site. Step 1: Request a D2L course site at: <https://csr.d2l.arizona.edu>. Your D2L course will be created and you will have access immediately to the course site.

Step 2: To access your D2L course site, log in using your UA NetID and Password at: <https://d2l.arizona.edu/>
